 Author Visit to Ash Lee Jefferson We had an author / artist come in to visit 4 of our classrooms in the month of March. 3/4 Gibbon, 4 Ross, 3 Hobbs and 5 Cannon. The author / artist is Briana Corr Scott. She is the author of several picture books such as: "If you could be anything", "Wildflower", "Mermaid Lullaby" etc. Students watched an introductory video before her arrival and Brianna facilitated a writing and drawing workshop.
