Grade 5

- Our Schools Plus worker has begun the "Home Alone" program with our grade 5 students. The Home Alone Program is designed to provide children with the necessary skills and knowledge to be safe and responsible when home alone for short periods of time. It will help then understand how to prevent problems, handle real life situations, and keep them safe and constructively occupied. The program is designed for children approximately 10 years old.

Registration

Library

- Ms. Lake (our new librarian) has reorganized the library and is using the bulletin board in her room to recognize times of the year such as African Heritage Month, Leap Year Day, etc.

Hope for Wildlife

- Hope for Wildlife is visiting our $1 / 2 \mathrm{O}^{\prime}$ Connell and grade 2 Chaisson/Ayers classes. This ties into the curriculum for Science, allowing students to explore concepts about animal adaptations to their environment (in relation to the weather and concepts about animals being nocturnal.

Fieldtrips have begun for some classes.

Lockview is doing the musical 'Legally Blond'. Teachers will be encouraged to take their classes.

Shelley inquired with the SAC if they are willing to support a bookfair next year. This could be a fundraiser for the library. It might be during the parent/teacher interviews. We would need volunteer to help during the event. The SAC indicated that they are very interested in being part of a bookfair.
